- **Housing Options Breakdown**
 - **Apartments at Crocus:** Affordable one- and two-bedroom units offering independence with onsite supports and amenities like multipurpose rooms, exercise facilities, and a respite unit.
 - **Care at Crocus:** A "home within a home" model offering 24/7 support in community homes. These include private suites, shared living spaces, sensory and calming rooms, and outdoor areas for connection and tranquility.
 - **Homes at Crocus:** For-sale duplexes or townhomes in a neighborhood setting intended for families and individuals who provide natural, informal support to residents.
- **Community Engagement & Services**
 - **The Centre:** Provides residents and the broader community access to life skills education, leisure programming, social interaction, and health-centered activities.
 - **Supportive Housing Hub:** Serves both residents and their caregivers with support services, training, and resources, fostering independence and well-being.
 - **Community Pavilion:** Positioned in a shared green space, this facility is designed for events, gatherings, and inclusive community programming.
 - **Try-It-Out & Respite Apartments:** Trial living options and short-term respite stays are provided to gauge fit and offer relief for caregivers.
- **Mission & Values**
Rooted in the idea of transformation, COC draws inspiration from the crocus flower—symbolizing rebirth, hope, dignity, and thriving together. Its mission emphasizes choice, affordability, well-being, community inclusion, quality care, independence, and sustainability.
